Funeral Services Held Here Today

Mrs. V. Alice Ewart, wife of the late Thomas Ewart and closely united in bonds of affection with all the Ewart family who have been prominent in Poweshiek county for so many years, died Sunday, Jan. 4, at her residence, 5137 Drexel Boulevard, in Chicago. The body was brought to Grinnell this morning and funeral services were held this afternoon from the Smith Undertaking Parlors, conducted by Rev. A. B. Cadwell. Services were also held Monday afternoon at the home in Chicago. Burial was in the Ewart mausoleum in the Ewart cemetery.

Mrs. Ewart was born in Canada and before her marriage was Victoria Aldis and she was a sister of Mrs. James S. Ewart of this city. Her husband, who died many years ago, was a brother of J. S. Ewart and the other Ewart boys and was also a brother of Mrs. Mark Sturgeon of Grinnell and Mrs. F. C. Rayburn of Oskaloosa.

Mrs. Ewart left Ewart a number of years ago, and for a time lived in Grinnell but about ten years ago moved to Chicago where her home has since been.
